## Rifle, Pistol & Trap Range Rules

- 1. Range hours: Monday through Saturday, 8:00am to 6:00pm Sunday, 12:00pm to 6:00pm
- 2. Gate leading to the rifle range must remained lock at all times. Unlock, enter, then re-lock prior to proceeding to the rifle range.
- 3. Range flag must be raised prior to using the shooting ranges.
- 4. Eye and ear protection are mandatory while on the shooting ranges.
- 5. No member shall fire a 50 caliber or larger BMG cartridge.
- 6. All firearms must be pointed down range at all times.
- 7. Always keep your finger off the trigger until ready to shoot.
- 8. When anyone is down range, firearms must remain on the bench or in the rack with action open and the gun unloaded.
- 9. Intentional shooting birdhouses, wood/steel fence posts and steel target frame stands is prohibited.
- 10. No ground targets are allowed.
- 11. The range is closed during maintenance and grass cutting.
- 12. Any member has the right to challenge an unknown person for proof of membership.
- 13. The Tri County Sportsman Club is not a public facility. Only key holding members or members accompanied by a key holding member are allowed to use the ranges.
- 14. The key holding member will be held responsible for any and all actions committed by a non-key holding member accompanying them on the ranges.
- 15. All minors, under 18 years of age, must be closely supervised by an adult Tri-County Sportsmen Club member.
- 16. Members must supply own birds for use on trap range.
- 17. On trap range, must use 7 shot or above. No buck shot.
- 18. Buckets will be supplied for spent shells and cartridges.
- 19. Shooters must clean up after shooting. This includes picking up shotgun wads on the ranges. Please take all garbage along with you.
- **20**. As of July 2023, ATV's and UTV's may enter the Club property and **must** stay on paved or gravel surfaces. For work days and routine maintenance they may be approved to use as needed. **No other exceptions.**
- 21. No alcoholic beverages are allowed on the shooting range grounds.
- 22. Those who violate club rules will be expelled.

Ranges are open year round (roads are not plowed in the winter – use best judgment).

Let us all be an ethical shooter. Ethical shooting is doing the right thing when no one else is watching.
